

Information we collect

We collect the information which helps us to improve quality of our services or provide them to our users. Some of the information may also be collected by third party services which are used on this website.

- User information. To provide some of services, for example, the subscription for newsletters and announcements, we request some of your Personally Identifiable Information (PII): for instance your name and email address. We can ask you to inform us with your birth date, e-mail address and password while online registration or filling in the questionnaires on the site. This personal information is using only for providing our services to the users.
- Location. When you visit our website, we automatically collect and keep for not a long time on our server your internet IP address, type of browser, operational system, date and duration of your presence on this site, the information of site's pages which you've visited, and of your usage of the site's search service. This information could be used to define your location, including the automatic choice of the optimal website localization.
- Behavioral tracking. In order to make the usage of website more comfortable, we can collect behavioral statistics and watch the user's behavior on our website. For example to collect the information about cursor moves and clicks on site's active elements (buttons, links, images) via Google Analytics.
- Cookies. Like many other websites, we can send you one or few cookie files i.e. small text files which serve as unique identifier of your browser or your session on our site. We use the cookie files to simplify the usage of our website. For instance, we provide you the option "remember me" on this website during the registration or any following authorization. Cookie files can also be used by third party services which are implemented into our site. We are not responsible for and have no access to such files on third party resources.
